ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a shelter station for passengers located at the junction of Riverside-Redondo Boulevard and Vermont Avenue on its Watts-Redondo line in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map (Marked C.E.H. 10517) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that the shelter station herein proposed to be abandoned and removed is owned by applicant and is constructed on private right of way; that during the power shortage several years ago the stop at this point was eliminated and has never been restored and the shelter station is of no use or benefit to the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be

and it is hereby granted to Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, to abandon and remove its passenger shelter station located at the junction of Riverside-Redondo Boulevard and Vermont Avenue on its Watts-Redondo line in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, as more definitely shown in yellow on map (Marked C.E.H. 10517) attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
