SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, R. S. Cassady, to whom the Railroad Commis-  
sion granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity author-  
izing an automobile service (seasonal) for the transportation of  
passengers and property between Blairsden and Gold Lake Beach Resort  
and between Blairsden and Salmon Lake Resort, in a supplemental  
application, has petitioned for an order of the Commission amending  
said certificate by providing that the service beyond "Boat Landing"  
near the foot of Gold Lake, for passengers destined to or originating  
at Gold Lake Beach Resort, and points intermediate between "Boat  
Landing" and Gold Lake Beach Resort, shall be operated as an "on call"  
or "on demand" service, instead of on schedules, and

WHEREAS, applicant Cassady declares that at said boat  
landing his auto stages will be met by boats operating to and from  
said Gold Lake Beach Resort, affording passengers destined to or  
originating at the resort as well as those originating at or destined  
to Salmon Lake Resort and other points, an opportunity to avoid an  
automobile trip over a road described by applicant Cassady as rough  
and uncomfortable, and

WHEREAS, applicant Cassady declares he is ready and  
willing to transport by auto to and from Gold Lake Beach Resort,  
such passengers as may have an aversion to a boat trip, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the supplemental application of R. S. Cassidy for authority to operate an on call or demand service for the transportation of passengers and property between Blairsden and Gold Lake Beach Resort be and the same hereby is granted subject to the following provisions:

1. That passengers destined to or originating at Gold Lake Beach Resort shall be transported to and from said resort by automobile if they elect to travel by auto instead of by boat to and from a point designated as "Boat Landing" near the foot of Gold Lake.

2. That the authority herein granted shall not be construed as authority to in any way remove the restrictions contained in Conditions No. 1 and 2 of the Commission's Order in Decision No. 16,765, as amended by Decision No. 17,126, nor shall it be construed as authorizing any change in the scheduled service now being given between Blairsden and the point designated as "Boat Landing."
