BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Scholes on its Shasta Division in Shasta County.

Applicant alleges that Eight (8) Dollars of passenger business was transacted at the non-agency station of Scholes during the annual period ending February 28, 1927; that no freight business is transacted at said station of Scholes and that no freight tariffs are published in connection with freight business; that the abandonment of said non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public. The California Farm Bureau Federation has been consulted in the matter and through its Manager, J. J. Deuel, has advised the Commission that said organization has no objections to offer to the granting

of this application.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station of Scholes located on its Shasta Division in Shasta County, to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records, to discontinue service to said non-agency station and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all tariffs and time schedules to said point.
