SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Peter J. Alberigi, to whom the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 10304, dated April 12, 1922, and issued on Application No. 7678, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile service for the transportation of passengers and property between Pt. Reyes Station and Pt. Reyes, in writing, under date of June 9, 1927, requested authority to discontinue operation of said service, basing his request on the declaration that for three months immediately preceding June 1, 1927, his receipts totaled \$282.05, with expenses of \$260.43, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Peter J. Alberigi be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue operation of the automobile service between Pt. Reyes Station and Point Reyes he was operating under authority of a certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 10304, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Peter J. Alberigi shall immediately file supplements to tariffs and time schedules on file in his name with the Railroad Commission, which supplements shall withdraw said tariffs and time schedules, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Peter J. Alderigi in Decision No.10304 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
