FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission on the twentieth day of June, 1927, having issued its Decision No. 18533, authorizing Spring Valley Water Company, a corporation, to grant certain rights of way over roads extending from the so-called "Stone Circle" upon the Woodside-San Mateo Road across Crystal Springs watershed lands to West Union Creek Tract in the County of San Mateo, upon certain specified terms and conditions, one of which (numbered Paragraph 4) required the consent of the City and County of San Francisco, and it now appearing that the above rights of way have been specifically exempt and excluded under the terms of the option to purchase the properties of applicant, given to the City and County of San Francisco, and that there is, therefore, no necessity for such a requirement, and other good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this Commission's Decision No. 18533, dated the twentieth day of June, 1927, be and it is hereby modified to eliminate therefrom the requirements set out in Paragraph 4 of the Order therein.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects
this Commission's Decision No. 18533 shall remain in full force
and effect.
