SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

Complaint having been made to the Railroad Commission that V. V. Anderson to whom a certificate of public convenience and necessity was issued for the operation of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, freight and express between Winters, in Yolo County, and Monticello, in Napa County, and intermediate points, as granted by this Commission's Decision No. 9053 on Application No. 6522, was operating equipment between Winters and Sacramento in addition to the service authorized by certificate, and that V. V. Anderson was not operating his authorized service between Monticello and Winters in accordance with schedules as filed with the Railroad Commission, an order to show cause why said certificate should not be revoked was issued by the Commission and duly served on said V. V. Anderson, respondent.

A public hearing on the order to show cause was conducted by Examiner Handford at Sacramento, at which time evidence was received and the matter duly submitted.

We have given full consideration to the record in this proceeding and are of the opinion that the order to show cause heretofore issued in this proceeding should be dismissed.

O R D E R

A public hearing having been held on the above entitled proceeding, respondent having appeared in answer to the Commission's order to show cause, evidence having been received, the matter having been duly submitted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the order to show cause heretofore issued against V. V. Anderson be and the same hereby is dismissed.
