O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a wig-wag signal located at drill track crossing of Main Street, in the City of El Centro, County of Imperial, State of California. Applicant has constructed and now maintains and operates a certain drill track across Main Street in said City of El Centro under authority granted by this Commission in Decision No. 13092, dated January 28th, 1924, (Application No. 9512). A wig-wag signal has been installed in said Main Street at the crossing hereinabove described, as required by Ordinance No. 260 of the Board of Trustees of the City of El Centro, passed and adopted on the 24th day of October, 1923. Applicant states that traffic upon said Main Street has never justified the expense of installing and maintaining a wig-wag signal at said crossing. Upon a showing to that effect by Southern Pacific Company, the Board of Trustees of said City of El Centro, on February 16th, 1927, passed a resolution granting Southern Pacific Company permission to remove said wig-wag signal.

An inspection on the ground by a member of the Commission's Engineering Department verified the above facts with respect to the lack of necessity for a wig-wag signal at this location.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon and remove the wig-wag signal located at drill track crossing on Main street, in the City of El Centro, County of Imperial, State of California, at the location shown in yellow color on blueprint map (Los Angeles Division Drawing B-205) attached to and made a part of the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
