Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its shelter station located at Bartolo on its Los Angeles Division in Los Angeles County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business was transacted at the shelter station of Bartolo during the annual period ending July 1, 1927; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of said shelter station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation has been consulted in the matter and has advised through its Manager, J. J. Deuel, that it has no objections to the granting of this application.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be

and it is hereby granted to Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, to abandon its shelter station at Bartolo located on the Main line of its Los Angeles Division in Los Angeles County, State of California; provided, however, that coincident with the abandonment of said shelter station applicant will continue to serve said station as a non-agency station by all trains stopping at that point.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
