FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission by Decision No. 17434 dated October 5, 1926, authorized Roseville Water Company to issue and sell \$180,000.00 of its six and one half percent bonds due 1951 subject to the condition, among others, that approximately \$10,753. of the proceeds might be expended only for such purposes as the Commission might authorize in supplemental orders; and

WHEREAS, in the supplemental decision, No. 17881, dated January 12, 1927, the Commission authorized the company to use \$6,002.50 of said \$10,753. of the proceeds to pay for certain costs and expenses; and

WHEREAS, the company in a supplemental petition filed in the above entitled matter on July 19, 1927 asks permission to use the remaining \$4,750.70 to reimburse its treasury; and finance the cost of capital additions set forth in Schedule "A" attached to said supplemental petition; and


WHEREAS, the Commission is of the opinion that the request should be granted and that the expenditures herein authorized are reasonably required by applicant and are not in whole or in part reasonably chargeable to operating expense or to income, therefore,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 17434 dated October 5, 1926 be, and it hereby is, modified so as to permit Roseville Water Company to use \$4,750.70 of the proceeds received from the sale of the bonds authorized to be issued by said decision for the purpose of reimbursing its treasury, paying indebtedness, and financing the cost of the following expenditures:-


1,987 feet of four inch pipe laid along Douglas and Nevada Streets	\$2,215.50
1,476 feet of four inch pipe laid along Durante to Atkinson Street	1,671.84
578 feet of four inch pipe laid along Park Drive	644.47
190 feet of four inch pipe laid along Fourth Street	211.85
Miscellaneous expenditure in connection with the above	7.04
Total	<u>\$4,750.70</u>

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 17434 dated October 5, 1926, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Fourth Supplemental Order.
