FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission on the eighth day of July, 1927, having issued its Decision No. 18575, authorizing Spring Valley Water Company to grant to the County of Santa Clara an easement or right of way for a county road across certain of its lands in order to provide a roadway around the high-water line of Calaveras Reservoir upon certain specified terms and conditions, one of which (numbered Paragraph 2) required the consent or approval of the City and County of San Francisco, and it now appearing that such consent or approval by said City and County of San Francisco is not necessary in this particular instance and other good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this Commission's Decision

No. 18575, dated July 8, 1927, be and it is hereby modified to the extent of eliminating therefrom the requirements set forth in Paragraph 2 of the order therein.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects said Decision No. 18575 shall remain in full force and effect.
