FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission on the eighth day of July, 1927, having issued its Decision No. 18577, authorizing Spring Valley Water Company, a corporation, to transfer and convey to the City and County of San Francisco for street and roadway purposes certain of its property located in Block 68, Stanford Heights, in exchange for certain other and adjacent property to be conveyed to Spring Valley Water Company by Meyer Bros., a corporation, upon certain specified terms and conditions, one of which (numbered Paragraph 2) required the consent or approval of the City and County of San Francisco, and it now appearing that such consent or approval by said City and County of San Francisco is not necessary in this particular instance and other good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this Commission's Decision No. 18577 be and it is hereby modified to the extent of eliminating therefrom the requirements set forth in Paragraph 2 of the Order.
