IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Francisco-Richmond Ferry Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to withdraw from the Wells Fargo Bank and Union Trust Company the sum of \$16.50 which was obtained from the sale of the stock authorized by Decision No. 8144, dated September 24, 1920, as amended, and to use such sum for the purpose of paying the State Corporation Tax for 1927 assessed against said San Francisco-Richmond Ferry Company, and Wells Fargo Bank and Union Trust Company is hereby authorized to permit the withdrawal of said \$16.50 by San Francisco-Richmond Ferry Company for such purpose.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the orders heretofore made in this application shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Supplemental Order.
