IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that South Coast Gas Company has filed with the Commission in satisfactory form a stipulation, as provided in Decision No. 18594 dated July 8, 1927 which states that said company, its successors and assigns, will never claim before the Railroad Commission or any court or other public body a value for the rights and privileges granted by Ordinance No. 512 of the City of Oceanside in excess of the amount actually paid to the City of Oceanside as the consideration for the granting of such franchise, which amount is stated at \$25.00.
