SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Union Pacific Stage Company, a corporation, in a supplemental application, has applied for an order of the Commission changing the time of operation of an automobile service for the transportation of passengers and baggage to Death Valley points for which it was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity by the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 18337, from the time between October 1st of each year and May 15th of each year to the period extending from November 1st to April 30th of each year, and

WHEREAS, said supplemental application is based on the claim that the weather in Death Valley during said October-to-May period is too hot to justify operation of said service, now  
Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order of the Railroad Commission fixing the time of operation of stage service authorized to be performed by Union Pacific Stage Company in Decision No. 18337 be and the same hereby is amended to require operation of said service from November 1st of each year to April 30th of each year.
