IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the One Hundred and Sixty-fourth Supplemental Order of August 26, 1925, and the One Hundred and Eighty-fifth Supplemental Order of May 13, 1927, in the above entitled proceeding be and the same are hereby amended to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time during which Home Telephone Company of Covina may reconstruct its overhead electric lines to conform to the provisions of Chapter 499, Statutes of 1911 as amended by Chapter 600, Statutes of 1915, be and the same is hereby extended to October 1, 1927, provided that as to certain infractions listed as "Technical prior to October 22, 1911" upon copies of the field reports heretofore referred to, such time is hereby extended until such infractions can be eliminated in the course of maintenance or construction work."
