## EESCRIPTION OF CROSSITG.

Beginnine at a point on the easteriy line of Railroad Street, distant northeriy thereon four hundred eighty Leet (430') more or less, from the northeriy line of School Street, thence in a northwesterly direction on a curre concare to the le-t, crossing Railroad Street to a joint on the westeriy line of hailroad Street, aistant northeriy thereon six hourcea Iorty-five feet ( $645^{7}$ ) more or less from the said northeriy Ine of School. Street.

The above crossing shail be identilied as Crossing Mo. E-8.06-C.

Said crossine to be constructed subject to the following conditions, namely:
(I) The entire expense of constructing the crossing to gether with the cost of its maintenanoe therearter in good and first-class condition for the safe and convenient use of the public, shall be borne by applicant.
(2) Said crossing shell be constructed equal or superior to type shom as Standara No. 2, in General Order No. 72 of this Commission und shail be constracted without superelevation and or a wiatt to comrorm to that portion of said street now graded; Trith the tops of rails flush with the roadway, and with grades of approach not exceedine three (3) per cent; shall be protected by a suxtable crossing sign anc shall in every way be made sefe For the passade thereorer of vehicies and other roac trafific.
(3) 2ppifeant shail, witinin thirty (30) days thereafter,
notify this commission, in writing, of the completion of tine installation of said crossing.
(4) If said crossing shall not have been installed Within one year ix om the date of this order, the authorization herein granted shall then lapse and become void, ness further time is granted by subsequent order."
(v) The Commission reserves the right to make such furtian orders relative to the location, construction, operation; maintenance and protection of said crossing us to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the prbilc convenience and necessity demand such action.
