ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its Greystone station and the abandonment and removal of three spur tracks at said Greystone station located on its Coast Division in Santa Clara County, State of California, and shown in yellow on a blue print map (marked "Coast Division Drawing No. 43,051") attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business was transacted at the non-agency station of Greystone during the annual period ending February 28, 1927, that no freight business was transacted at said station during the annual period ending March 31, 1927, and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of this non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public. The California Farm Bureau Federation

has been consulted and, through its Manager, J. J. Deuel, has advised the Commission that it has no objections to offer to granting of this application.

The McGilvray-Raymond Granite Company was the principal shipper at this point for a number of years, but is not now conducting operations at that point and has ignored the correspondence of the Commission in this matter.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station of Greystone and to abandon and remove three spur tracks at said station located on the New Almaden Branch of its Coast Division in Santa Clara County and more definitely shown in yellow color on blue print map marked C.E.E. 10,750 attached to and made a part of this application and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
