SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

This Commission, in its Decision No. 18408, approved a certain contract entered into by and between applicant and Sulphur Bank Syndicate. It now appears that the original contract has since been changed by mutual consent of the parties involved through the substitution of the words "Schedule No. P-1" in lieu of the words "Schedule No. P-5." Applicant has requested the Commission to issue its supplemental order approving said contract as amended.

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 18408 be and it is hereby changed as follows:

That portion of the opinion reading "Schedule Number P-5" be changed to read "Schedule Number P-1."

In all other respects the said decision shall re-

main unchanged.
