The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the reclassification of its station at Algozo on its Arvin Branch, Valley Division in Kern County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that no less than carload business was transacted at said station during the annual period ending July 31, 1927; that the applicant and the Southern Pacific Company maintain a joint station at this location, which station is maintained by the said Southern Pacific Company as a carload freight station only, while in petitioner's time table said station is shown as a station for the receipt and delivery of both carload and less than carload freight. Petitioner therefore requests authority to change the classification of said Algozo Station from both a carload and less than carload station to one for receipt and delivery of carload freight only.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application

should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, to reclassify its station at Algozo located on the Arvin Branch of its Valley Division in Kern County, State of California, as set forth in its application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
