Wilnby Wright, Frank Chapman Willson, and Codfred Thuesen, as trustees, associates doing business under the firm name and style of Bay Shore Freight Limes, and having provided in condition six of the order in said decision, that such authority would become effective when there had been filed with the Commission a stipulation wherein the holders of the first mortgage notes of South Shore Port Company agreed not to institute any foreclosure proceedings prior to March 1, 1928, and a stipulation, signed by all but the holders except those owning \$7,500.00 of the

notes, having been filed in the above entitled matter on October 6, 1927, and applicant having asked the Commission to modify its decision so that said stipulation be sufficient compliance therewith and
