ORDER

The Sunset Railway Company has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Lio in Kern County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that no business was transacted at the non-agency station of Lio during the annual period ending May 31st, 1927; that the Standard Gil Company, the only interested shipper and receiver of carload freight, has been interviewed by applicant and has expressed its approval to the proposed abandonment; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation, through its Manager, Mr. J. J. Deuel, has advised that it has no objection to the granting of this application.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to the Sunset Railway Company to abandon its non-agency station of Lio, in Kern County, State of California, and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records; and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time schedules to and from said point.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
