ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR MODIFICATION OF OPINION AND
ORDER AND FOR REHEARING AND RE-ARGUMENT

It appearing that by its decision of July 8, 1927, in the above proceeding this Commission found unjust and unreasonable the refrigeration charges assessed under the provisions of Perishable Protective Tariff No. 3, C.R.C. No. 2, applying to butter, eggs, cheese and dressed poultry in carload lots, and by its order required the carriers to publish and establish on or before September 1, 1927, charges not in excess of those provided by Section 4 of Perishable Protective Tariff No. 3;

It further appearing that the carriers defendant published July 23, 1927, effective September 1, 1927, in Supplement

No. 12 to Perishable Protective Tariff No. 5, C.R.C. No. 2,
the rates ordered into effect by this Commission;

It further appearing that the carriers, parties de-
fendant, filed August 22, 1927, a petition for modification
of opinion and order and for rehearing and re-argument;

It further appearing that after reconsideration of
the record in the above entitled proceeding and defendant's
petition for modification of the opinion and order and for re-
hearing and re-argument thereon, and there being no good cause
for a modification of the opinion and order nor for rehearing
and re-argument,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the said petition for modi-
fication of order and for rehearing and re-argument be and it
is hereby denied.
