hereby authorized to carry into effect on or before November 1, 1927, the agreement hereinbefore mentioned and which is hereby approved, subject to the following conditions.

(1) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of this order file with this Commission a certified copy of said agreement duly executed.

(2) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the operation, maintenance, etc. of said interchange tracks as to it may seem right and proper and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
