ORDER

Spring Valley Water Company, a corporation, having applied to this Commission for authority to grant to the County of Alameda a right of way for a public highway over its watershed lands to take the place of certain roads and portions of roads lying within and approaching Calaveras Reservoir, the City and County of San Francisco heretofore, by agreement, having given its consent to the granting of necessary rights of way for public purposes over the properties of applicant now under option to the City and County of San Francisco, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Spring Valley Water Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to grant to the

County of Alameda those certain rights of way for highway purposes, as more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, subject to the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before December 31, 1927.
2. A certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said Spring Valley Water Company within thirty (30) days from the date of this order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
