O R D E R

Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of its shelter shed at the station of Collins on its Los Angeles Division in San Bernardino County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business was transacted at the station of Collins during the annual period ending November 1, 1927; that no freight business was transacted at said station during the same period; that applicant has constructed a grape loading platform at Collins station which platform is now being used for receipt and delivery of freight; and that in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of said shelter shed at Collins station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation has been consulted in this matter and through its Manager, J. J. Deuel, advises it has no objections to offer to the granting of this application.

Investigation by the Transportation Division of the Engineering Department of the Commission discloses that the said shelter shed was constructed many years ago and is deteriorating and that the newly constructed loading platform is sufficient to

take care of the business at this location.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, to abandon and remove its shelter shed at the station of Collins, located on the main line of its Los Angeles Division in San Bernardino County, State of California.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
