IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Western Pacific Railroad Company be, and it hereby is, authorized to use \$369,533.89 of the

proceeds received from the sale of the bonds authorized by Decision No. 17046, dated July 2, 1926, for the purpose of reimbursing its treasury, in part, on account of expenditures for additions and betterments made during the period between December 1, 1926 and September 30, 1927, as shown in detail in Exhibit "1" attached to the supplemental petition filed in this proceeding on December 8, 1927.

IT IS HEREEY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 17046, dated July 2, 1926, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
