SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Geo. F. Martin, to whom this Commission in its Decision No. 15250, dated August 3, 1925, and Decision No. 15430, dated September 19, 1925, both issued on Application No. 11452, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automotive trucking service in the vicinity of Lakeport, has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of December 7, 1927, that he has discontinued said service and disposed of his equipment, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Geo. F. Martin in Decisions No. 15250 and 15430 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said Geo. F. Martin shall immediately file with the Railroad Commission supplements to his tariffs and time schedules which supplements shall cancel said tariffs and time schedules.
