FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Los Angeles Junction Railway Company, on October 11, 1927, filed a supplemental application on the above entitled proceeding in which permission is sought to construct its second track at grade across 46th Street in the City of Vernon, the original authority to construct said track under this Commission's Decision No. 15120 having expired on June 30, 1926.

The supplemental application sets forth that all the double track crossings authorized in said Decision No. 15120 except the second track of applicant across 46th Street and across the tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company therein have been completed; that the City of Vernon is proceeding with the paving of said 46th Street and has completed said paving on both sides of said crossing, and has advised applicant that it will withhold paving of the intersection until said second track has been completed. Franchises and agreements for the crossing were filed with the

original application.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Los Angeles Junction Railway Company be and it hereby is authorized to construct its second track at grade across 46th Street in the City of Vernon and at grade across the spur track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in said street at the location and as shown by the map attached to Application No. 10649, subject to conditions set forth for the construction of said crossings under Decision No. 15120, dated June 30, 1925.

If said crossing shall not have been installed within one (1) year from the date of this order, the authorization herein granted shall then lapse and become void unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
