BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of CITY OF SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO and PACIFIC WATER COMPANY, a corporation, for an order authorizing a change of rates for fire hydrants in the City of South San Francisco.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Pacific Water Company, a corporation, engaged in the public utility business of supplying water for domestic, municipal and industrial purposes in the City of South San Francisco, has entered into a duly authorized agreement with said city for the installation of additional facilities for fire protection purposes which, it is alleged, will result in an annual saving to the citizens of South San Francisco of approximately \$7,000. in insurance premiums. In view of the fact that said additional and increased facilities are not now necessary to adequately supply existing demands for domestic, municipal and industrial service, said city has agreed to pay an increased fire hydrant rental, to wit: \$450. per month for 150 fire hydrants and thereafter \$2.00 per month per fire hydrant for each additional fire hydrant installed by the city, provided said utility installs at its own expense said improved facilities which are estimated to cost approximately \$26,267.

The said utility and the City of South San Francisco having mutually agreed upon said increased rates, the action of said city being duly authorized by a resolution of its City Council, regularly introduced and adopted on the fifth day of January, 1928, said city having joined in this application, it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the best interests of the public require that this application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Water Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized and directed to file with the Commission, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, the following rates for municipal fire hydrant rental, said rates to be charged for all service rendered subsequent to the thirty-first day of January, 1928.

MUNICIPAL FIRE HYDRANT RATES

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects the rates established by this Commission in its Decision No. 15506, dated October 9, 1925, shall remain in full force and effect.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
