SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Samuel Pinches, to whom this Commission in its
Decisions Nos. 5963 and 5923, dated respectively November 30, 1918,
and November 15, 1918, both being issued on Application No. 4209,
granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate
an automotive service for the transportation of passengers and
property between Longvale and Branscomb and intermediate points,
has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of January 7,
1928, that he is no longer operating said service and desires that
the certificate heretofore granted to him by said decisions be re-
voked and annulled, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience
and necessity heretofore granted to Samuel Pinches in Decisions
Nos. 5963 and 5923 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled,
and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said Samuel Pinches shall
immediately file with the Railroad Commission supplements to his
tariffs and time schedules, which supplements shall cancel said
tariffs and time schedules.
