Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Samuel Pinches in Decision No.7888 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said Samuel Pinches shall immediately file with the Railroad Commission supplements to his tariffs and time schedules, which supplements shall cancel said tariffs and time schedules.
