O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the relocation of its shelter shed at its non-agency station of Hall, on its Western Division in Alameda County, and shown on a blue-print map (Western Division Drawing No. H-77, Sheet No. 1) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that the proposed construction of a packing shed and a 370-foot spur track at said Hall Station will necessitate the removal of said shelter shed from its present location to a point approximately 200 feet northerly thereof, and said shelter shed in said proposed location will be more accessible to the patrons of applicant than it is in its present location; that the relocation of said shelter shed at said non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the relocation of said shelter shed at said non-agency station is necessary for the business of the applicant and for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to relocate the shelter shed at its non-agency station of Hall, located on the Alviso Line of its Western Division in Alameda County to a location shown in red on map (Western Division Drawing No. H-77, Sheet 1) attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
