FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, David Easdale was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a vessel for the transportation of persons for compensation on the Russian River between Russian River Heights, Guerneville, Greystone, Neeley's Beach, Murphy's Beach and Guerneville, by our Decision No. 15894, Application No. 12160, January 23, 1926, and

WHEREAS, under date of January 18, 1928, the said David Easdale having advised the Commission that he had found it impossible to operate vessels in compliance with the order and that no service had ever been rendered under the certificate, and request having been made that the authority as granted by the certificate of public convenience and necessity be cancelled,

THEREFORE, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to David Easdale in Decision No. 15894, Application No. 12160, be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled.
