

Decision No. 13337.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of SUISUN AND GREEN VALLEY TELE- PHONE COMPANY for an Order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California authorizing the establishment of rates for exten- sion telephone service and the filing of schedules providing therefor.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

WHEREAS, Suisun and Green Valley Telephone Company has made application to this Commission for authority to establish and make effective rates for service over extension telephones, and

WHEREAS, this Commission has heretofore found such rates reasonable for similar service under similar conditions in other telephone exchanges in California, and

WHEREAS, the furnishing of service over extension telephones is in the interest of the applicant's subscribers and it appearing that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Suisun and Green Valley Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to make effective a rate of one dollar (\$1.00) per month for business

or residence extension service with wall telephone set and a rate of one dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) per month for business or residence extension service with desk telephone set on and after March 1, 1928, providing such rates be submitted for filing with this Commission on or before February 20, 1928.
