OBINION

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, seeks authority to relocate two sections of its Watts-Redondo Line, viz. on San Pedro Street, between the stations of Hermosillo and Bridgedale, and on Electric Street, between the stations of Perry and El Nido, all in unincorporated sections of Los Angeles County. Such relocation requires the construction of twelve new grade crossings, the plan and profile for which are shown on applicant's Exhibits "A", "B" and "C", and the elimination of fourteen existing ones.

A public hearing on this matter was held at Los Angeles on January 10, 1928, at which time the matter was submitted.

The Board of Supervisors of Los Angeles County plan to improve and pave San Pedro Street, between Hermosillo and Bridge-dale, and Electric Street, between Prairie Avenue and Hawthorne

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at each of the following crossings: Normandie Avenue, Moore Avenue, Lowell Street, Western Avenue, Prairie Avenue and Hawthorne Avenue. Said automatic flagmen shall be of a type and installed in accordance with Standard No. 3 in General Order No. 75 of this Commission. The entire cost of installing said automatic flagmen and their maintenance thereafter shall be borne by the applicant.

- (4) Applicant shall remove the tracks shown in yellow on the map marked C.E. 7675, Exhibit "A", attached to the application, as soon as the new tracks are in service.
- (5) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the installation of said crossings.
- (6) If any or all of said crossings shall not have been installed within one year from the date of this order, the authorization herein granted shall then lapse and become void, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.
- (7) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders, relative to the location, construction, operation; maintenance and protection of said crossings, as to it may seem right and proper and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.

The foregoing Opinion and Order are hereby approved and ordered filed as the Opinion and Order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
