 tion, for permission to discontinue
 service of street railway operation
 over a portion of its so-called San
 Jose Avenue line in the City of Ala-
 meda, and to substitute therefor the
 operation of a passenger motor bus
 service over the same route for a
 period of sixty (60) days.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the authority granted appli-
 cant, Key System Transit Company, in Decision No. 19255, dated
 January 12th, 1928, on the above entitled proceeding to discon-
 tinue the operation of street railway service for a period of
 sixty (60) days over portions of its so-called San Jose Avenue
 and High Street lines in the City of Alameda, as more particu-
 larly described in said Decision and to substitute motor bus
 operation in lieu thereof be and it is hereby revoked.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that Key System Transit
 Company be and it is hereby directed to re-establish the said
 street car services heretofore authorized to be discontinued.
 Applicant shall post notices for a period of one (1) day in all
 busses operated over said San Jose Avenue and High Street lines,
 advising the Public of discontinuance of said bus service and

resumption of street car service therefor.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
