BY THE COMMISSION:

NINTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

Whereas in Decision No. 9125, (20 C.R.C. 64) in the above entitled matter this Commission provided, with reference to the rates therein established, that such rates would be subject to increase or decrease by amounts as set forth therein, upon approval of the Railroad Commission, based upon a change in the price paid for oil in the various communities served; and

Whereas Schedule No. G-10, applying in Sacramento, is subject to increase or decrease by amounts as set forth therein, based upon a change in the price paid for oil, upon approval of the Railroad Commission; and

Whereas Pacific Gas and Electric Company now makes affidavit that, by a contract executed January 26, 1928, but effective as of December 17, 1927, the price paid for oil was decreased by various amounts in different localities served; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company decrease the rates for gas service, as determined in Decision No. 15626, effective for all meter readings taken on

and after February 27, 1928, so that the rates of the several schedules shall be less than the basic rates of the respective schedules set forth in Decision No. 9125 by the following amounts:

Schedule No.	G-1	13 Cents per 1,000 cubic feet
"	" G-3	23 " " "
"	" G-4	15 " " "
"	" G-5	16 " " "
"	" G-6	16 " " "
"	" G-9	18 " " "

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company decrease the rates for gas service rendered under Schedule No. G-10, effective for all meter readings taken on or after February 27, 1928, so that the rates therein shall be one (1) cent per 1,000 cubic feet less than the rates heretofore set forth in Schedule No. G-10.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company file with the Commission on or before February 27, 1928, revisions of its schedules as herein authorized.
