SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, F.A. Hodges, to whom this Commission in its Decision No. 7300, dated March 22, 1920 and issued on Application No. 5270, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an auto trucking service as a common carrier between San Jose and San Juan, has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of February 4, 1928, that he is no longer operating said service, now

Therefore good cause appearing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to said F.A. Hodges in Decision No. 7300 be, and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said F.A. Hodges shall immediately file supplements to tariffs and time schedules on file in his name with the Railroad Commission which supplements shall cancel said tariffs and time schedules.
