BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of an Investigation on the Commission's Own Motion into the service, practices and operations of A. WAINWRIGHT, operator of an automotive trucking service between Oakland and San Francisco on the one hand and Turlock and other points.

BY THE COMMISSION:

<u>O P I N I O N</u>

On January 23, 1928, the Commission on its own motion issued its order in the above matter directing an investigation of the practices and operations of defendant in the exercise of his certificate to operate an automotive trucking service between Turlock, Keyes, Ceres, Modesto, Salida, Ripon and Manteca, on the one hand, and San Francisco and Oakland, on the other hand, together with the order of the Commission to the defendant to appear and show cause why his said certificate should not be revoked.

Thereafter on February 10, 1928, after due notice to defendant, a public hearing was held in San Francisco before Examiner Rowell, at which time the defendant failed to appear. At said hearing the Commission introduced in evidence the record in Application No. 10839 and Decision thereon No. 16884, dated June 11, 1926, granting to defendant his said certificate, tosether with the correspondence pertaining thereto. From such correspondence it appears that defendant has not operated under certificate granted to him. It appears, however, that he has

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refused to make written application to the Commission for cancellation of said certificate, and for that reason the above order was issued on the Commission's own motion.

It is hereby found as a fact that defendant has failed to operate at any time under said certificate and that the same has been abandoned.

<u>o r d e r</u>

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA having on the 23dday of January, 1928, issued to A. Wainwright its order to show cause why his certificate to operate an automotive trucking service should not be revoked, a public hearing having been held, and the matter being now ready for decision,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public ∞ nvenience and necessity heretofore issued to A. Wainwright by Decision No. 16884 on Application No. 10839 to operate, under the fictitious name of Valley Transportation Company, an automotive trucking service for farm and orchard produce from Turlock, Keyes, Ceres, Modesto, Salida, Ripon and Manteca and intermediate points, on the one hand, and San Francisco and Oakland, on the other hand, be and the same is hereby revoked; and

and time schedules IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs/heretofore filed by A. Wainwright be and the same hereby are cancelled.
