BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Belvedere Water Corporation, a corporation, having applied to this Commission for authority to grant to County of Los Angeles, which joins in the application, a perpetual easement and right of way over and across certain of its lands for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and using a sanitary sewer, and it appearing that the granting of such easement and right of way will not interfere with the operation of said corporation and will be of material benefit to said County of Los Angeles, and it further appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Belvedere Water Corporation, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to grant to the County of Los Angeles a perpetual easement and right of way for

the purpose of constructing, maintaining and using a sanitary sewer and appurtenant structures over and across a certain strip of land six feet wide, being the northerly six feet of Lot 8 of Tract 2553, in the County of Los Angeles, and as more particularly described in, and substantially in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the application herein and the exhibit attached thereto which are hereby referred to and made a part of this Order, subject, however, to the following further conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such easement and right of way as shall have been conveyed on or before June 30, 1928.
2. A certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said Belvedere Water Corporation, a corporation, within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
