SIXTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Decision No. 12580 (23 C.R.C. 841) in the above entitled matter, provides, with reference to the steam rates of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, that such rates be subject to increase or decrease upon approval of this Commission on the basis of three (3) cents per thousand pounds of steam for each ten (10) cent increase or decrease, respectively, per barrel in the price of oil above or below the price in effect on August 1, 1923, and

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas and Electric Company now makes affidavit that, by a contract executed January 26, 1928, but effective as of December 17, 1927, the price paid for oil was decreased by six (6) cents per barrel, so that it is now nine (9) cents more than the basic price upon which rates were established in Decision No. 12580,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Pacific Gas and Electric Company reduce its present rates for steam effective for all meter readings taken on and after February 27, 1928, so that

said rates shall be equal to three (3) cents more than the basic rates on file with the Commission as established in said Decision No. 12580.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, file with the Commission on or before February 27, 1928, a revision of its schedules as herein designated.
