ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its agency at the station of Army Point on its Western Division in Solano County.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business was transacted at the agency station of Army Point during the annual period ending September 30, 1927; that practically all of the freight received at and forwarded from said station is for or from the United States Arsenal at that point; that business to and from said Army Point can be handled conveniently from the agency station at Benicia; that the United States Commanding Officer at said Arsenal has signified his willingness to handle business to and from said Arsenal through said agency station at Benicia; that the abandonment of said agency at said station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and, that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the agency at said station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its agency at the station of Army Point located on the Main Line of its Western Division in Solano County and to eliminate said agency from its station records.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
