NINTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

This proceeding having been reopened by the Commission for hearing and further determination, a public hearing having been held at Palo Alto on February 14, 1928, and it appearing from the record that a further extension of time for the maintenance of the grade crossing heretofore authorized in this proceeding should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time limit for the maintenance of the grade crossing at the intersection of Palo Alto Avenue and Alma Street over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company at Palo Alto, as specified in the Commission's Decision No. 9338, dated August 9, 1921, in the above entitled matter, be and it is hereby extended to June 30, 1928.

In all other respects this Commission's prior decisions in this matter shall remain in full force and effect.
