SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, G. W. Johnson and J. M. Johnson, co-partners, to whom this Commission in Decision No.7393, dated April 8, 1920, and issued on Application No.5417, granted authority to operate a trucking service between Cloverdale and Navarro and who were authorized by Decision No.9027, dated May 28, 1921, and issued on Application No.6621 to extend said service to Geyserville, have requested, in writing, under date of March 1, 1928, authority to discontinue said service, declaring that it is an unprofitable operation, and

WHEREAS, the annual report of G.W. and J.M.Johnson, covering their operations for the year 1927 shows an operating revenue of \$2081.50 with expenses totaling \$3663.24, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that G.W. and J.M.Johnson, co-partners, be and they are hereby authorized to discontinue trucking service heretofore authorized to be operated by Decision No.7393 and Decision No.9027, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the operating rights heretofore granted by said decisions be and the same are hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said G.W. and J.M. Johnson, co-partners, shall immediately file supplements to tariffs and time schedules on file in their names with the Railroad Commission, which supplements shall cancel said tariffs and time schedules.
