BY THE COMMISSION:

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission, in its Decision No. 17609, ordered that Willard F. Smith might change his rates for telephone service to those shown in Exhibit "B", a part of that order, after a showing that he had completed certain construction and reconstruction work, and after approval by Supplemental Order by this Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission has evidence to the effect that Willard F. Smith has completed the construction and reconstruction work referred to in Decision No. 17609,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Willard F. Smith be and he is hereby authorized to publish, file and make effective as of April 1, 1928, the schedules of rates authorized in Decision No. 17609, and shown in Exhibit "B" attached thereto, provided that said schedules of rates be submitted for

filing with this Commission on or before March 31, 1928 .

For all other purposes the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
