SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, A. G. Newcomer, to whom this Commission in its Decision No. 14114, dated October 1, 1924, and issued on Application No. 9962 granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an auto trucking service between Redding and a point about nine miles beyond the post office at Coffee, Trinity County, and intermediate points, has advised the Commission, by telegram, under date of March 3, 1928, that he has abandoned said service, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to said A. G. Newcomer by Decision No. 14114 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said A. G. Newcomer shall immediately file with the Railroad Commission supplements to tariffs and time schedules on file in his name with said Railroad Commission, which supplements shall cancel said tariffs and time schedules.
