BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, filed the above entitled application with this Commission on the twenty-seventh day of December, 1927, asking for permission to be relieved from the compliance with Section V-a of this Commission's General Order No. 75 and, in lieu thereof, to be permitted to maintain the existing signs, consisting of a crossing sign 3' 2" x 2' 6", supported by an iron pipe, at certain crossings listed in this application and located in the City of Los Angeles.

The Commission's Engineering Department has investigated this matter and prepared a report containing a recom-

mendation that, under the conditions, the existing signs be permitted to remain in place. It appears to the Commission that this application is reasonable and should be granted and that this proceeding is not one in which a public hearing is necessary; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to maintain the existing non-standard signs in lieu of the type of signs designated as Standard No. 1, in Section V-a of this Commission's General Order No. 75, at the various intersections designated in this application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
