O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its freight platform at Bangle on its San Pedro Line, Southern Division in Los Angeles County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map (CEE 11059) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that no less than carload business was transacted at said station during the year 1927; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the freight platform is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, to abandon its freight platform at Bangle located on the

San Pedro line of its Southern Division in Los Angeles County.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
