O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a portion of a storage track extending into and across a portion of Craven Avenue in the City of Torrance, in Los Angeles County, and shown in yellow on a blueprint map (C.E.H. 10994) attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that the piece of track herein proposed to be abandoned is owned by applicant and is in a public street; that the track has not been used for many years and that it is impractical to use it as cars cannot be stored in the street. The Engineering Department of the Commission has made a field investigation of this track and reports that there appears to be no objection to the granting of the application. The City of Torrance has advised the Commission by letter that the City consents to the granting of the application.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Pacific Electric Railway Company to abandon and remove that portion of its storage track extending into and across a portion of Craven Avenue in the City of Torrance, Los Angeles County, and as more definitely shown in yellow on map (C.E.H. 10994) attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
