BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of CEMENT, TOLENAS AND TIDEWATER RAILROAD COMPANY for an order authorizing discontinuance of passenger train service and cancellation of passenger tariffs.

Cement, Tolenas and Tidewater Railroad Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the discontinuance of its passenger train service on its railroad between Tolenas and Cement, Solano County, California, and the cancellation of its passenger tariffs. It appears that all passenger train service on this line is for the purpose of providing transportation in and out of the town of Cement; that all the residents of said town are employees of the plant of the Pacific Portland Cement Company, located at Cement; that said plant is to be closed and that when the plant is closed there will be no inhabitants in the town of Cement and no further need for passenger train service. It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to the Cement, Tolenas and Tidewater

Railroad Company, a corporation, to discontinue the operation of its passenger trains on its railroad between the towns of Tolenas and Coment, Solano County, California, upon one day's notice to the public and to the Commission, and to cancel all intrastate passenger tariffs, carrying rates for transportation of passengers between points on the lines of applicant within the State of California.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
